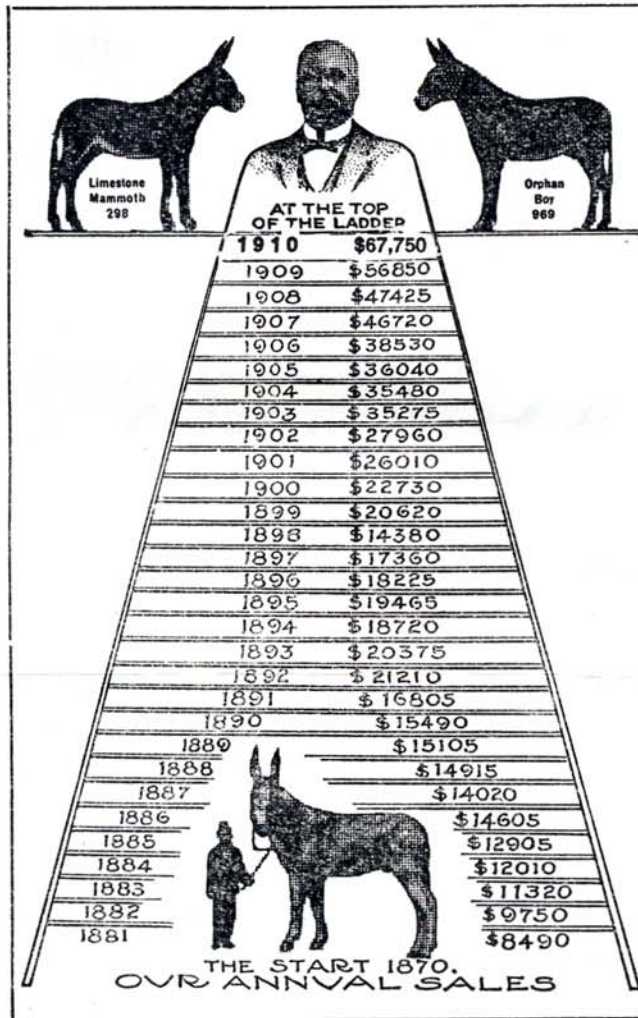

At the St. Louis Exposition we won a total of 72 ribbons on thirty head of animals and was restricted to two entries in each class or could have won more prizes.

At the Panama Pacific Exposition we won a total of 66 ribbons on fourteen head of animals and were not entered in three classes, making a total at the two expositions of 138 prizes, which was more than all the other exhibitors won at the two expositions.
