# **RULES OF ENTRY**

# APPLICATION BY PEDIGREE

- 1. JACKS, JENNETS and GELDINGS of any age may be accepted to registry without regard to measurement when their sire and dam are registered with the AMJR/SJJR. EXCEPTION(S) explained as follows:
  - The registry reserves the right, at any time, to visually inspect an animal for which the application to registry by pedigree is submitted.
  - b. The registry also reserves the right, at any time, to require a certificate and/or affidavit from a licensed veterinarian certifying height, size, color and/or age of an animal for which acceptance to registry by pedigree is being sought.
- Application must include name of animal, color, sex, date of foaling and name and address of breeder and owner. 2.
- In registering foundation stock, give name and AMJR/SJJR registration number of sires and dams as far back as possible. 3.

### APPLICATION BY MEASUREMENT

- JACKS MUST MEASURE NO LESS THAN 14.2 hands, standard measure, in height; at least 61 inches around heart girth; and at least 8 inches at 1. cannon bone (measured around cannon bone midway between the knee and fetlock).
- JENNETS and GELDINGS MUST MEASURE NO LESS THAN 14 hands, standard measure, in height; at least 61 inches around the heart girth; and 2 at least 7-1/2 inches at cannon bone (measured around cannon bone midway between the knee and fetlock).
- When applying for registry by measurements, submit THREE (3) PHOTOS with the application showing the entire animal clearly, front, rear and side 3. view.
- This registry reserves the right, at any time to: 4.
  - visually inspect an animal for which application by measurements is being submitted; a.
  - b. require a signed certificate and/or affidavit from a licensed veterinarian, stating the height, size, color and/or age of an animal for which application by measurements is being sought;

The registry reserves the right to deny acceptance to registry for animals of questionable pedigree and/or breed characteristics. EXAMPLE: A burro cross is not a characteristic of this breed. An animal bearing the burro cross is not eligible for acceptance to registry. White and spotted animals are not true examples of this breed and not eligible for registration.

Animals registered before maturity, are issued a certificate that includes no measurements, and is considered to be a temporary registry entry. A registry update form is required to be submitted when the animal reaches maturity (typically at five years of age). Upon receipt of the update, and verification by the AMJR Registrar that the animal meets the registry requirements, a permanent certificate of registry is issued.

Should any person or persons knowingly impose a fraudulent pedigree and/or certificate of measurements on this registry, he or they will never be allowed to enter another JACK, JENNET or GELDING in the records of this registry.

#### FEES FOR ACCEPTANCE TO REGISTRY: 1.

- Single Application:
  - a. JACK OR JENNET (any age) \$25.00
  - GELDING (any age) \$15.00 b.
- 2. Herd Rate. Payment of the total fees for the qualifying number of registry applications, i.e. 20 applications x \$13 each = \$260 total fees, must be received
  - before any certificates will be issued:
    - 50 or more \$10 each jack or jennet a.
    - b. 40 to 49 \$12 each jack or jennet
    - 20 to 39 \$13 each jack or jennet c.
    - \$15 each jack or jennet d. 10 to 19
    - \$20 each jack or jennet 5 to 9 e
- NOTE: Herd rate fees require payment of the total fees for the qualifying number of registry applications (i.e. 20 applications x \$13 each = \$260 total fees) at the time the first application is submitted. No certificates will be issued until the fees for ALL qualifying applications are paid.

# DUPLICATE OR CORRECTED CERTIFICATE

For DUPLICATE of lost or destroyed certificate of registration and/or for CORRECTED CERTIFICATE of registration, the fee is \$25.00.

#### TRANSFER OF OWNERSHIP

- For TRANSFER OF OWNERSHIP the fee is \$15.00 per transfer; provided the application for transfer, registry certificate and transfer fee are received at 1 the office within sixty (60) days after date of sale/transfer of ownership. The transfer fee is subject to an increase after that date.
  - It is the responsibility of the seller and/or the buyer to **TRANSFER** an individual animal when selling and/or buying.

### THE REGISTRY MAKES NO PROVISION FOR CHANGING THE NAME OF ANY AMJR/SJJR REGISTERED JACK, JENNET or GELDING.

#### INTERNATIONAL REGISTRATION

An additional \$10.00 postage fee for international registrations.

#### FEES MUST ACCOMPANY APPLICATION TO REGISTRY, TRANSFER OF OWNERSHIP, UPDATE REPORT, AND DUPLICATE OR CORRECTED CERTIFICATE.

# DEATH OF A REGISTERED ANIMAL

Upon the death of an AMJR/SJJR registered JACK, JENNET or GELDING, the original registry certificate MUST be surrendered to the registry office.

# IMPORTANT

Read all rules and notes before filling out application to registry. Take care to make every word legible to avoid delays or errors in issuing your certificate.

#### EXPLANATORY NOTES

- The HEIGHT MEASUREMENT must be taken at the highest point of the wither by the standard, an official horse measuring device. Rulers, tapes and/or carpenter levels are NOT adequate for accurate measurement.
- The HEART GIRTH MEASUREMENT is taken around the body by passing a tape over the area of the heart. 2.
- 3. The CANNON BONE MEASUREMENT is the circumference of the cannon bone, measured around the smallest point of either front leg between the fetlock and knee.
